

Regulated charges passenger flight at Brussels Airport

The charges for passenger flights at Brussels Airport depend on several factors. There is a fixed tariff per passenger (cf. passengers charges, security charges and charges for persons with reduced mobility PRM) and a variable tariff per flight depending on the weigth of the aircraft, environmental factors and the time of departure or landing (cf. landing and take of charges LTO).

An evolution of the basic regulated unit charges (parking excluded) is shown in the figure below.

In 2016, Brussels Airport reduced their charges on average with 5,2%. In the next regulated period, starting in april 2023, a general increase in charges was seen, together with the start of a shift of passenger charges to LTO charges.

Obviously, the charges evolve due to several reasons, such as inflation or necessary investments (such as the inclusion of the fuel & oil activities starting from 1 augustus 2024) and can also change as a result of incentives.
